
IMPROVING CONNECTIONS FOR DRURY-OPĀHEKE EAST

In Drury East we are investigating new and upgraded corridors for public transport, cycling and walking as well as options to improve access to and from State Highway 1 and the proposed Mill Road corridor.



There are a number of options being considered that we would like your feedback on.

All options have:

- Upgraded east-west connections over State
 Highway 1 at Bremner Road and Quarry Road
- A train station located in proximity to Flanagan Road and Waihoehoe Road
- A frequent bus corridor with cycle and walking facilities from Drury West, connecting the train stations, centres and employment areas.

North-south connections

We are considering two options to extend the frequent bus corridor with cycling and walking facilities north towards Papakura, either via:

- Opāheke Road (proposed as part of Transport for Urban Growth network in 2016)
- A new link through the proposed industrial area connecting with Hunua Road.

East-west connections

We are considering upgrades to the following existing roads in Drury East to bring them up to an urban standard within the future growth area. These upgrades may result in either two or four lanes of traffic and include walking and cycling facilities.

- Ponga Road
- Waihoehoe Road
- Fitzgerald Road.
